Dennis Noel Jackson was born December 26, 1941 in Bakersfield, California to Coleman Jesse Jackson and Margaret Evelyn (Roche) Jackson. He passed away Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at his home near Castle, Oklahoma at the age of 77.

Dennis grew up and graduated High School in Bakersfield, California. He proudly served his country with the United States Marine Corps from 1959-1963 and later re-enlisted in 1965-1967. Dennis, in 1979, went to work for the offshore drilling department of Kerr-McGee Corporation; working overseas a majority of the time. He later went off to work as an engineer for large boats and tow boats. On May 19, 1984 in Oklahoma City; he married Ann Elizabeth Henrichsen. They owned and operated the Last Chance RV Park and Campground for many years before selling three years ago. Dennis will be dearly missed.

He is preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Carol.

Survivors include his wife, Ann of the home; one daughter, Monica Austin and husband Jeremy of Virginia; one brother, John Jackson of Pittsburgh; one step-brother, Greg Roche of Los Angeles, California; one sister, Evelyn Shear of Bakersfield, California; three grandchildren, Zack, Tony and Benjamin Austin and a host of cousins and dear friends.
